

## **AEROMEXICO ANNOUNCES NEW ROUTE TO CHETUMAL**

- Starting June 1, 2020, Aeromexico will introduce daily service between Mexico City and Chetumal, Quintana Roo.

**Mexico City, March 2, 2020.** – As part of Aeromexico’s business strategy to reinforce its presence in the domestic market, starting June 1, the airline will serve daily flights between Mexico City and Chetumal, further strengthening the airline’s network to southeast Mexico and increasing tourism in the region.

With this new route, Aeromexico will serve the top six destinations in southeast Mexico. The airline currently offers flights from Mexico City to Campeche, Cancun, Ciudad del Carmen, Mérida, and Villahermosa, with close to 29,000 seats per week.

Darío Flota Ocampo, General Director of the Quintana Roo Tourism Board, said: "These flights will meet the growing demand of tourists in search of authentic travel destinations, and international passengers will now be able to easily connect to Chetumal from Europe, the United States, and Canada to enjoy the city's diverse attractions."
